Friday, March 7 <sup>b</sup>	Research Question; Select Outcomes Faculty will: (1) draft a research question; (2) select outcomes	
Friday, April 4 <sup>b</sup>	Conceptual Frameworks Faculty will: (1) identify conceptual frameworks; (2) consider how to use them for instructional design and/or evaluation	
Friday, May 9 <sup>b</sup>	<b>Study Design</b> Faculty will: (1) select a study design; (2) recognize strengths and limitations of the study design	
Friday, June 6 <sup>b</sup>	<b>Survey Design</b> Faculty will construct survey items, response options, and discuss analysis methods to address research question	
Friday, July 11 <sup>b</sup>	<b>Validity</b> Faculty will develop a plan to gather validity evidence for their survey instruments
